Jig Swatches Puzzle Class

3 Hours

Looking for a fast and easy quilt? Whip out this adorable puzzle quilt. This is a great way to use up fat quarters or other large scraps, and incorporating fun conversation prints makes it even more special. Pre-cutting will enable you to make major progress on this quilt during the class (see below).

Materials List

- ✂ 10-20 fat quarters of fabrics (novelty prints with more tonal prints that read as solids)
- ✂ 1 yard border fabric
- ✂ ½ yard binding fabric
- ✂ 2 ½ yards of backing fabric, piece to 50x70"
- ✂ 50x70" piece of batting
- ✂ Sleeve and label fabric, if desired

Supplies

- ✂ Freezer Paper
- ✂ Iron
- ✂ Small travel iron or quilting iron without steam holes, capable of high temperatures*
- ✂ High quality, large tweezers
- ✂ Spray or liquid starch in a small container or cup
- ✂ ¼" stencil brush
- ✂ Hard pressing surface (can be made with 2 layers of canvas and a single layer of batting)
- ✂ Basting glue with fine tip applicator*
- ✂ Rotary cutter for use on paper, rulers, and mat
- ✂ Sewing machine, neutral colored piecing thread and general sewing supplies
- ✂ Remove all selvages from fabrics.

Pre class preparation:

Cut a total of thirty-five 7 ½" x 11 ¼" rectangles. Two of these should be cut from the border fabric. From each of these, cut a 7 ½" square, and two 3 ¾" squares.
